Parts of Speech

- Noun

Noun

- Name of person place or thing
- Example: Nadia, Indus River, table, city etc
- Two basic types
- Common and Proper Noun

Verb

- Action words are called verbs
- Example: run, eat, drink, make etc

Adverb

- Adds information to verb
- Qualifies a verb
- Qualifies an adjective
- Also qualifies another adverb
- Example: in the park, fast,
- He was running fast.

Adjective

- describe nouns or pronouns.
- Examples: Another, any, tall, some, beautiful etc.

Preposition

- Words that link nouns or pronouns to other words within a sentence with sentence
- Examples: on, in, over, under, within

Conjunctions

- Words that link other words, phrases, or clauses in a sentence.
- Examples: for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so

Interjections

- Words that are used as exclamations or to express feeling.
- Examples: Hey! Oh! Darn! Wow!
