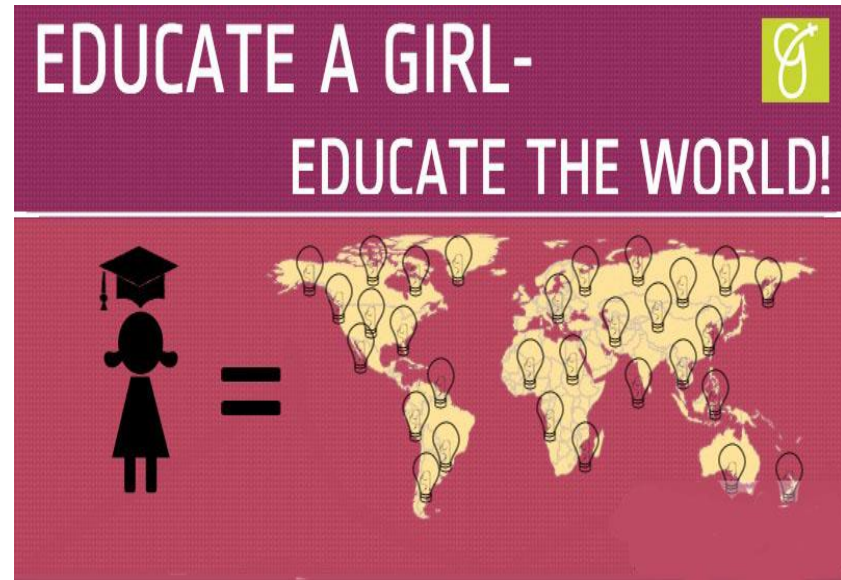


Women Education

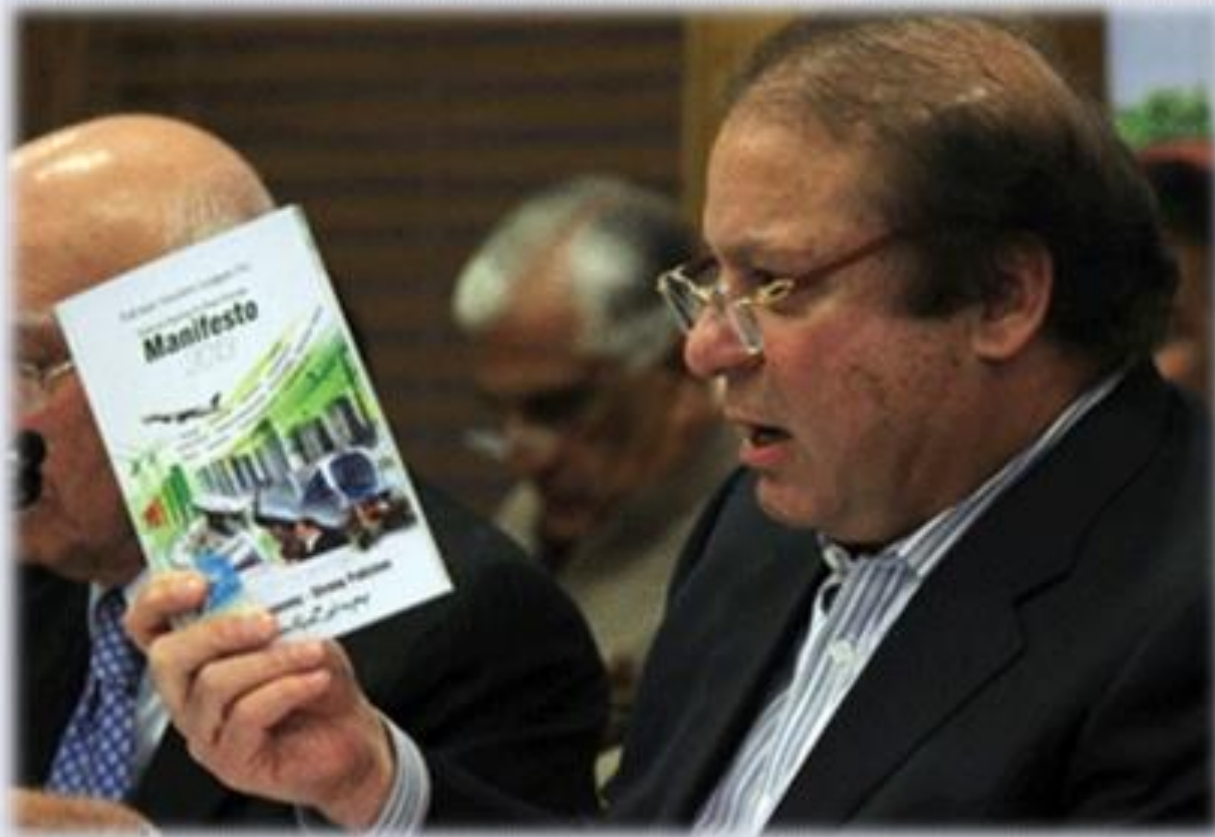
As of 2010 the literacy rate of females in Pakistan is at 39.6 percent compared to that of males at 67.7 percent.
