Materialism	Spiritualism
Materialism is constant concern over material possessions and wealth, a great excessive regard for worldly concerns.	Spiritualism is a philosophic doctrine, opposing materialism that calms transcendence of the driving being the altogether spiritual character of reality and the value of inwardness of consciousness.
Materialism believes on monism which means only one substance exists, this substance is a matter (body).	Spiritualism believes on dualism which means two substances exist, matter and mind.
Man can be known only by describing the matter.	Man does not consist of only mind or matter.
Absence of beliefs in supernaturalism.	Beliefs on God (Allah), soul, next world reincarnation, superstitious, supernatural systems of explanation.
Self-consciousness is an illusion that is generated by the complexity of the organization of matter.	Soul is autonomous.
Man has an illusion of autonomy. He is subjected to determination or random.	Man is autonomous.
Absence of meaning of life. Man fixes itself his own finality, humanity.	Spiritual finality often of divine origin.
Man is a part of nature like animals.	Man dominates nature.
Man is a product of evolution.	Man is a creation.
What are called "Mysteries" are only questions unsolved by sciences.	There are mysteries that human cannot give reason and never be able to solve.
In materialism theory, Ignorance must be accepted.	Ignorance is transformed into transcendence "stoppage" or substitute like God.
