Guidelines for the Paper

The Mid-term Examination: 30 Marks

- The mid-term paper will consist of the following two sections: short questions and long questions.
- There will be five short questions in total, each carrying two marks.
- There will be two long questions in total, each carrying ten marks.
- The short and long questions will be based on: **(a)** the information provided in each chapter of Dr. B.R. Mullik's *A Critical History of English Literature*, and **(b)** the notes provided to the class throughout the semester.

The Final-term Examination: 50 Marks

- The final-term paper will consist of the following two sections: short questions and long questions.
- There will be five short questions in total, each carrying four marks.
- There will be three long questions in total, each carrying ten marks.
- The short and long questions will be based on: **(a)** the information provided in each chapter of Dr. B.R. Mullik's *A Critical History of English Literature*, and **(b)** the notes provided to the class throughout the semester.

Sessional Marks: 20
