Methods of Teaching <div><div>• The students will deliver their presentations using white board and oral lectures, or by using AV aids such as multimedia or skype or YouTube or WhatsApp.</div><div>• The students will participate in question and answer session after the presentation to give answers to audience questions related to the presentation.</div><div>• The students will provide their presentation in Microsoft ppt format or written assignment form to their fellows and course instructor.</div><div>• The students will be required to complete their presentation in 15 minutes and 5 minutes will be reserved for question and answer session.</div><div>• The students will be evaluated against six parameters. Each parameter will have 5 marks. The six parameters are: (a) Content & Knowledge; (b) Communication Skills; (c) Ability to Answer Questions; (d) Mode of Delivery; (e) Time Management; and (f) Submission of Presentation in ppt slides format or written assignment form (Must follow APA style, 7th edition)</div></div>
