

C# String Contains()

The C# Contains() method is used to return a value indicating whether the specified substring occurs within this string or not. If the specified substring is found in this string, it returns true otherwise false.

Signature

```
public bool Contains(String str)
```

Parameters

str: it is a string object which is used to check occurrence in the calling string.

Return

It returns boolean value either true or false.

C# String Contains() method Example

```
using System;

public class StringExample
{
    public static void Main(string[] args)
    {
        string s1 = "Hello ";
        string s2 = "He";
        string s3 = "Hi";
        Console.WriteLine(s1.Contains(s2));
        Console.WriteLine(s1.Contains(s3));
    }
}
```

Output:

```
True
False
```
