

C# String IsNullOrEmpty()

The C# IsNullOrEmpty() method is used to check whether the specified string is null or an Empty string. It returns a boolean value either true or false.

Signature

```
public static bool IsNullOrEmpty(String str)
```

Parameter

str: it is a string parameter which is used to check string.

Return

It returns boolean value.

C# String IsNullOrEmpty() Method Example

```
using System;
public class StringExample
{
    public static void Main(string[] args)
    {
        string s1 = "Hello C#";
        string s2 = "";
        bool b1 = string.IsNullOrEmpty(s1);
        bool b2 = string.IsNullOrEmpty(s2);
        Console.WriteLine(b1);
        Console.WriteLine(b2);
    }
}
```

Output:

```
False
True
```
