

C# String StartsWith()

The C# StartsWith() method is used to check whether the beginning of this string instance matches the specified string.

Signature

```
public bool StartsWith(String str)
public bool StartsWith(String, Boolean, CultureInfo)
public bool StartsWith(String, StringComparison)
```

Parameter

str: it is string type parameter which is used to check beginning of string.

Return

It returns boolean value.

C# String StartsWith() Method Example

```
using System;

public class StringExample
{
    public static void Main(string[] args)
    {
        string s1 = "Hello C Sharp";
        bool b1 = s1.StartsWith("h");
        bool b2 = s1.StartsWith("H");
        Console.WriteLine(b1);
        Console.WriteLine(b2);
    }
}
```

Output:

```
False
True
```
