- **Anger; no hesitation in killing a man who offended him, only he knows better.**

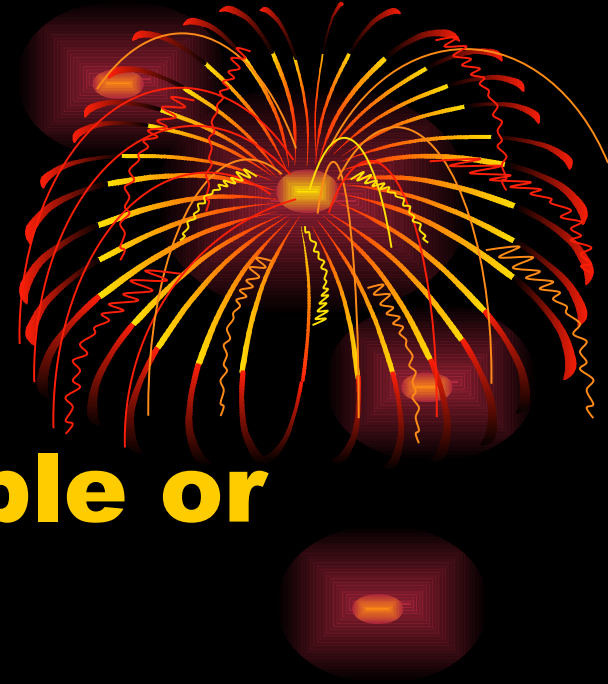
E.A. FARRINGTON

LIPPE

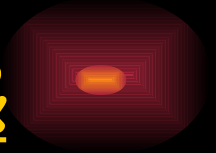


- **Great anguish in evening, almost driving one to commit suicide.**
