6. It is a left sided remedy, complains continuous relapse, red face and orifices of the body, severe burning.
7. A constitution Anal remedy for anemia in female and children, suffering from marked emaciation and mental fatigue. Defective bone development.
8. Anemic remedy with fair pale face with varicose veins, used initial complain of fever and inflammation with full, soft flowing pulse.
9. Women having craves for dirt, chalk, pica etc. Great in activity of rectum to passes stool.
10. Danger of suffocation from mucus in larynx. Stony hard swelling of glands.

1. Affection of mucous membrane with thick, tough, stringy, adherent mucous, which can be drawn into long string.
2. Remedy for the young anemic person with great paleness of mucous membrane with fiery red face, Diarrhea during the meal.
3. Hypersensitive to touch, pain, light. Tendency to croupy exudation. All discharges are profuse: foul, stitching and splinter like pain.
4. Tendency to obese particularly in female with delayed menses. Eruption on skin with honey like discharge.
5. Mental affection due to injury on head, loose cough due to pain in chest in lower left chest. Humid asthma in children from every change in wet weather.
6. Tall, slender, narrow chest, weak person, burning especially in palm and soles, Hemorrhagic diathesis. Slight wound bleed profuse.
7. Alternate mental, physical or sexual symptoms, Pride and overestimate of one's self. Nymphomania, stool hard black passed in small portions.
8. It is a left sided remedy, complains continuous relapse, red face and orifices of the body, severe burning.
9. Suffocative shortness of breath, coarse, loose, retelling cough. Chest full of mucus, which cannot expel. Thick white coated tongue.
10. Mentally and physically weak, feeble and tottering: childish behavior, glands swell and enlarged, infiltrate and suppuration.
