**Course Objectives:**

After completing this course, students will be able to:

1. Develop and improve their presentation skills
2. Learn how to summarize a particular topic/issue into a presentation of 10-15 minutes
3. Learn to answer answers to questions after the presentation
4. Develop and improve their communication skills
5. Enhance their knowledge base
6. Deliver effective before an audience

**Teaching Methodologies:**

- ✓ The students will deliver their presentations using white board and oral lectures, or by using AV aids such as multimedia or skype or youtube or whatsapp.
- ✓ The students will participate in question and answer session after the presentation to give answers to audience questions related to the presentation.
- ✓ The students will provide their presentation in Microsoft ppt format or written assignment form to their fellows and course instructor.
- ✓ The students will be required to complete their presentation in 15 minutes and 5 minutes will be reserved for question and answer session.
- ✓ The students will be evaluated against six parameters. Each parameter will have 5 marks. The six parameters are: (a) *Content & Knowledge*; (b) *Communication Skills*; (c) *Ability to Answer Questions*; (d) *Mode of Delivery*; (e) *Time Management*; and (f) *Submission of Presentation in ppt slides format or written assignment form (Must follow APA style, 7<sup>th</sup> edition)*
